




Are enough New Zealanders ontask to wear a mask and to contact trace at work and in public?


We asked New Zealanders whether masks and scanning should be compulsory, and whether the public are following health guidelines for avoiding the spread of Covid-19 by hygienic mask use, physical distancing and staying home when sick.



Barely half of respondents (51%) were in agreement/strong agreement, that workplace mask wearing should be compulsory; while public transport (77%) and public places (61%) had much more support.



A majority of respondents were in agreement/strong agreement on scanning, particularly on **public transport** (70%).



Most respondents were not using facemasks consistently or correctly, or consistently practising physical distancing in public. Only 63% said they always stayed home while sick.
